



## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### **What is the Called Out alignment?**

Called Out is an alignment around our first sermon series of 2017. Called Out is inspired by Pastor Chris's book of the same name. During Called Out, your group will explore how to identify and live out the specific callings God has given each of us.

### **When does the Called Out alignment begin?**

The Called Out alignment begins the week of January 8.

### **How long is the alignment?**

The alignment is four weeks long, aligning around the Called Out sermon series on the weekend.

### **How does the Called Out book fit into the alignment?**

Pastor's new book, Called Out, is the inspiration for the weekend series and alignment, Called Out. The alignment will not follow along with the content of the book, instead it will cover the same theme from different angles. While the book will provide ample content for discussion, it is separate from the content of the alignment.

### **What will the alignment material look like?**

The material for Called Out will look different than some of our past alignments. During Called Out, we will align specifically around the weekend message. That means instead of creating separate video content for each week, we will create a 3-5 minute highlight clip of Pastor's message. This shortened message, along with a discussion guide which dives deeper into the sermon, will be posted each Sunday at 1pm on the Called Out series page at <http://faithpromise.org/series/called-out>. In addition to a discussion guide based on the content of Pastor's message, each week we will post a Discovery Bible Study guide that can be used instead of the discussion guide. The Discovery Bible Study method is a great way to engage Scripture as a group. This method will take one passage highlighted in Pastor's message and dive deeper into what it means for your group. Please only use either the discussion guide or the Discovery Bible Study guide as trying to do both in one

group setting would be overwhelming for your group. The Discovery Bible Study guide will be posted on the Thursday or Friday prior to the weekend message so that may be a better choice for groups that meet early Sunday afternoon.

### **Where can I find everything I need for the alignment?**

Each Sunday the material for that week will be posted at 1pm on the Called Out series page, <http://faithpromise.org/series/called-out>.

### **Is there anything else I need to know?**

Yes! The week after the alignment ends, February 5th, is Super Bowl Sunday. At FP, we are calling this weekend, Showdown. As a part of Showdown weekend, we are encouraging each fpGroup to host a Super Bowl party. This will be a great chance to celebrate the end of the alignment and invite your neighbors and co-workers to get a taste of what community at Faith Promise is all about.

### **What is my next step after the alignment?**

If you are an existing group leader, decide what your next study will be by talking with your group about what they think would benefit the group. If you need help with this, please contact your coach. Remember you have access to a massive library of studies at <http://RightNowMedia.com>.

We would also encourage you to try the Discovery Bible Study method for a month or two with your group. Groups using it now are experiencing amazing discussion around Scripture.
