FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

When does the Madness alignment begin?

The Madness alignment begins the week of April 3.

How long is the alignment?

The alignment is six weeks long. Week one will be an introduction week (Launch Party) where you will gather for dinner/gamenight, review the covenant and watch the first video. Weeks two through five, are curriculum weeks. Week six will be a celebration week. There will be daily devotions for all six weeks.

Do I need to print the pdf booklet for everyone in my group?

We would suggest that you encourage your group members to visit the website and read the booklet there. Members will be able to download the curriculum to their digital device. If you really want hard copies and neither you nor others in your group have the ability to print, you may email groups@faithpromise.org and we will print them for you.

With all this talk of emotions, what do I do if something comes out in group that I am not equipped to handle?

You may want to review the interview with Pastor and Dr. Ann on the website. Faith Promise has a wide range of support ministries including the following:

Counseling with a licensed therapist. Appointments can be made by calling the church office at 865-251-2590, #0. Office hours are Monday-Thursday, 8-5 and Friday, 8-noon.

Celebrate—a place to heal and grow. Celebrate has a time of corporate worship followed by support groups that range from chemical dependency to anger management to DivorceCare.

Stephen Ministry—provides confidential, one-on-one, Christ-centered care and support to people experiencing difficult times in their lives such as loss of a loved one, job loss, terminal illness, and divorce. The ministry pairs individuals with a Stephen Minister who will come alongside them to provide emotional and spiritual care for as long as the need persists.

Deliverance Prayer Team—for people desiring to be set free from a stronghold in their life.

Always remember that your coach is a great resource if you need insight into how to deal with a situation in your group.

What is my next step after the alignment?
