

## Chained to the Chariot- Discussion Guide

### Connect

**Main Idea:** Any area of our lives where we are experiencing repeated failure is an area where Jesus is not Lord: conquerors must first be conquered. We as followers of Jesus need to be "chained to the chariot."

**Introduction:** This week, Pastor Chris preached about how we as believers need to be "chained to the chariot." We need to surrender every area of our lives to Jesus.

**Discussion Starter:** What comes to mind when you think about "victory"?

### Grow

**Primary Scripture:** 2 Corinthians 2:14-16, Romans 8:37, 1 Samuel 17:47, Matthew 8:5-10

#### Discussion Questions:

1. Read 2 Corinthians 2:14-16. What is an area of your life where you have seen surrendering to Jesus be the key to victory?
2. Read Romans 8:37. What challenges do you face that hinder you in seeing yourself as "more than a conqueror"?
3. Read 1 Samuel 17:47. What makes it difficult for us sometimes to trust the Lord to fight our battles for us?
4. Read Matthew 8:5-10. What qualities do we see in the centurion? What was it about him that made Jesus "marvel"?
5. What battles do you need to trust the Lord to fight for you right now? In what area of your life do you need to experience victory?

### Protect

Pray that each member of your group would be confident in their identity as "more than a conqueror" in Christ. Pray that no matter what each group member is facing, they would stay surrendered to Jesus and know He is working everything together for their good. Pray that everyone in the group would trust the Lord to fight their battles and know that every battle is His. Pray that every person in the group would experience complete victory in Christ.
