Main Idea: Sowing Seeds and Reaping a Harvest.

Introduction: This week, Pastor Chris spoke on sowing seeds and reaping a harvest. Sowing things to come that need to be reaped into reality: this is having a vision. Heart for the Harvest is not about equal giving but about equal sacrifice.

Discussion Starter: What does the harvest look like to you? What do you see where you live, work, play, and study?

Primary Scripture: Matthew 9:35-38, Matthew 14:13-21, Matthew 16:17-19, 2 Corinthians 9:6-11, and Jeremiah 32

Discussion Questions:

1. What role does faith play in reaping and sowing?
2. Read Matthew 9:35-38 and Matthew 14:13-21. How did Jesus' view of people differ from that of the disciples'?
3. Read Matthew 16:17-19. Peter was not a perfect man: he was a doubter, a denier, and a deserter. How did Jesus say He would use Peter? Share ways that God uses imperfect people to carry out His perfect purpose.
4. Read 2 Corinthians 9:6-11. How are we to give? Reflect and share about a time that God increased your resources after you gave with a joyful heart.
5. Read Jeremiah 32. How did Jeremiah demonstrate his faith? What would you do if God asked you to do something even though you wouldn't be around to reap the rewards? How are we as a Church like Jeremiah in our faith?

Protect
