Connect

Main Idea: We are called to share the Gospel as followers of Jesus, and that won't always be easy. Even when it's difficult or uncomfortable, we can still share the Gospel and win our world because the Holy Spirit is with us, empowering us! When we start following Jesus, He changes our comfort, cause, and commitment.

Introduction: Pastor Zac continued the Ghosted series this week. He reminded us that we are not unfit to share the Gospel. We are equipped because we are filled with the Holy Spirit!

Primary Scripture: Luke 9:57-62, Romans 10:13-14, and Luke 10:9-11

Discussion Questions:

- 1. Read Luke 9:57-62. When you started following Jesus, how did your outlook on comfort change?
- 2. Read Romans 10:13-14. What is your cause? What in your life shows that you live for that cause?
- 3. Read Luke 10:9-11. How committed are you to proclaiming that the Kingdom of God has come near?
- 4. Pastor Zac pointed out that a large amount of Christians say it is wrong to share our faith. Why do you think that is?
- 5. Where have you experienced the power of the Holy Spirit in your life?
- 6. What can you do this week to operate in the power of the Gospel through evangelism?
