Connect

Ice Breaker: Share a time in your life when you felt prompted to be generous or obedient in a specific way. How did it impact you?

Talk About It:

Heart for the Harvest is a season where we stop and reflect on what God has done and relaunch freshly into what God has called us to do as a church and as a movement that is called to win the world to Jesus.

Key Passages: Matthew 9:35-38

- 1. Matthew 9:35-38: Are you willing to pray for and be workers with a heart for God's Harvest?
- 2. We exist to win the world by equipping Christ followers to win their world starting with 1% of TN. What are some practical steps or personal commitments you can make to contribute to the vision of Faith Promise in your own life and community?
- 3. Read Matthew 9:37-38: Jesus emphasizes the need for workers in the harvest field. How does the idea of being generous with our time, talents, and treasures relate to being effective workers in the vision of the Church (to win the world to Jesus)?
- 4. Pastor Zac asked the question, "have we forgotten what is was like to be lost, hopeless, and alone?" Take time to reflect on this question.

Protect:

Take time as a group to pray and praise for the harvest that will come through our obedience to God's leading.

Grow:

Take intentional time this week for personal reflection and prayer to align your life with God's vision for His church: to win the world to Jesus. Identify one specific area in your life where you can increase your obedience to God's leading.
