Read Matthew 18:10-14

Read Luke 19:1-10



Verses 1-2

What areas do you frequent as you work, play, study, learn, and live?

What people are in those places that you know need to feel included (actually share their names, if you know them)?

Zacchaeus was very successful at his job—making money off the people. This made him an enemy to many.

What people in your life that, because of who they are or how they are, need the love of God?

Verses 3-4

Zacchaeus craved to be near Jesus, but he experienced an obstacle between them.

What keeps the people you know from knowing God?

How can you help remove obstacles that prevent access to God's community?

Verses 5-6

Why do you think Jesus was looking for Zacchaeus?

How can you look for people to invite into your community?

When have you been welcomed gladly? How did that impact your faith?

Verses 7-8

Do you worry what others will think if you reach out to the "wrong" people?

Zacchaeus was radically changed when he was welcomed in. How has your community changed you?

Verses 9-10

What life change have you seen occur in your community?

How does living in community change a household?
