

Loot Week 3 -Discussion Guide

Connect

Ice Breaker: Share about a time you gave (time, talent, treasure) to someone before they asked.

Talk About It: The enemy tells us that our faith and finances are PRIVATE matters. God says that faith and finances are PUBLIC matters.

Key Passages: Acts 4:32-37, 5:1-11, Proverbs 29:18-19

1. Read Proverbs 29:18, share a moment when having a clear vision or revelation from God significantly impacted your life. How does this verse inspire you to see God's guidance more earnestly?
2. Discuss a time when you faced a financial challenge or temptation and how you navigated it with faith. What lessons did you learn about trusting God with your finances?
3. The story of the early church in Acts 4:32-35 shows a radical approach to sharing and generosity. How can we apply this principle of open-handed living to our lives today, especially regarding our possessions and finances?
4. How are your hands when it comes to your loot? Are you more open-handed and generous? Or are you more close-handed and protective of your loot?
5. Reflecting on the story of Ananias and Sapphira (Acts 5:1-11), why do you think transparency and honesty are vital in our faith and financial dealings?
