

## What's Your Tomb Week 4 -Discussion Guide

## **Connect**

**Ice Breaker:** Take a moment and share about the day Christ saved you and made you His.

**Talk About It:** We believe that Jesus gets the final say! Jesus overcame sin and death to offer us eternal life in heaven, but also to provide us with the fullest life here and now.

Key Passages: John 19:30, Romans 6:14, 3:23, 10:9, Acts 2:38

- **1.** In what practical ways can we live out the victory of "It is finished" in our daily lives, especially when facing doubts or challenges to our faith?
- **2.** In what ways have you experienced or struggled with feeling separated from God, and how does the concept of Jesus overcoming sin and death speak to you personally?
- **3.** How can recognizing our own "tombs" or challenges, like unforgiveness or seeking worldly satisfaction, help us understand the significance of Jesus' resurrection in our personal lives?
- **4.** Reflecting on Romans 6:14's message that we are under grace, not law, how does this understanding of grace versus legalism influence your daily life and decisions?
- **5.** How does the declaration "It is finished" by Jesus on the cross transform your understanding of forgiveness and the finality of His sacrifice for our sins?

## **Protect**

As a group, ask for opportunities to share the message of Jesus' victory, "It is finished," with those who are separated from God, inviting them into a relationship with Him.
