Connect

Ice Breaker: Have you ever pursued something you thought would bring satisfaction, only to find it left you wanting more?

Talk About It: Complete satisfaction is not a pick-and-choose proposition. Meaning you cannot be satisfied a little by people, a little by stuff, and a little by God.

Key Passages: Nehemiah 8:10, Matthew 6:24, 2 Corinthians 10:4, John 4:13-14

- 1. When it comes to our joy, satisfaction, and self-esteem, are we serving two masters?
- **2.** Considering Nehemiah 8:10, how do you experience "the joy of the LORD" as your strength in daily life?
- **3.** What steps can you take to ensure your satisfaction and joy are rooted in God and not in the fluctuating standards and offerings of the world?
- **4.** How has the joy and satisfaction given by God impacted your life differently than worldly pleasures have?
- **5.** In light of John 4:13-14, what does it mean to you to drink from the water Jesus offers, promising eternal satisfaction?

As a group pray for discernment to recognize the "tombs" of worldly satisfaction in our lives and the courage to walk away from them.
