Connect

Ice Breaker: How do you ensure that everyone in a group or family setting feels included and noticed, especially during busy times?

Talk About It: How people treat you is not the barometer for your love, how Jesus treated you IS the barometer for your love.

Key Passages: Matthew 18:6-7, John 21:15-17, Matthew 4:19

1. Take three minutes and reflect on the question: Do I know that God wants me in His family? Share any revelations you receive from this moment of reflection.

3. Discuss a time when you felt like Peter, having to choose whether to "go back to fishing" or follow Jesus more fully—what did you learn from that experience?
