Connect

Ice Breaker: Everyone share a word that describes the Holy Spirit to you and who He is in your life.

Talk About It: We all have relationships, we all need relationships but the world puts walls where God meant there to be windows.

Key Passages: John 16:7, Acts 1:4-5, 8, Mark 9:33-35

- **1.** In your opinion, what would the world think about Christ if Christians thought more about others than themselves?
- **2.** Considering the analogy of driving a car with no gas or roasting a marshmallow without fire, how does the absence of the Holy Spirit in our lives affect our ability to live out our call as Christ followers?
- **3.** In light of the disciples' argument about who was the greatest (Mark 9:33-34), how does humility play a critical role in our relationships and spiritual growth, and why is it often so challenging to maintain?
- **4.** How does shifting our focus from 'ME' to 'HE' (the Holy Spirit) in our daily lives challenge the natural human inclination towards pride and self-centeredness, and what impact can this shift have on our relationships and ministry?
- **5.** In what ways does understanding and embracing the role of the Holy Spirit transform our daily walk with Christ and our effectiveness in winning our world?
