### **Connect**

**Ice Breaker:** If you had to start a journey with no destination in mind, what's the one must-have item you'd bring along?

#### Talk About It:

God goes first, but we go next and follow Him. Now is the time to worship in faith. Pray in faith. Serve in faith. Give in faith. Love in faith. Fast in faith. Read in faith. Believe in faith. Just like Abraham.

**Key Passages:** Acts 7:1-7, 51-58 Matthew 12:34, 21:13, John 8:44, Genesis 12:1-9, Philippians 1:6

- **1.** What can we learn from Abraham's willingness to follow God's call without knowing where it would lead?
- **2.** Reflecting on Genesis 12:6-7, what does Abram building an altar signify about his relationship with God, and how can we incorporate similar practices in our lives?
- **3.** What steps can you take to strengthen your faith and trust in God's plan for your life?
- **4.** How does the story of Saul's transformation into the Apostle Paul illustrate the power of God's grace and call?
- **5.** What significance does Stephen attribute to Abraham's journey in Acts 7:1-7, and how does this shape our understanding of faith?
