Connect

Ice Breaker: What is one valuable lesson you've learned from your mother or a mother figure in your life?

Talk About It: The story of Deborah serves as a reminder that God equips and uses those who are willing to serve faithfully, demonstrating that victory comes through faith and obedience.

Key Passages: Judges 4:4-10 & 14, John 3:1-2, 2 Corinthians 4:8-9, 1 Corinthians 15:57

- 1. How can 'sitting with the Holy Spirit' transform our approach to making decisions and leading others?
- 2. What role does courage play in our spiritual lives, and how can we encourage each other to act boldly in faith?
- **3.** What are some practical ways we can cultivate the habit of spending time with the Holy Spirit through prayer and reading Scripture?
- 4. Considering Judges 4:14, where Deborah assures Barak of God's presence in battle, how can we identify and respond to God's guidance in our own challenging situations?
- 5. In what ways does 2 Corinthians 4:8-9 encourage us to persevere through difficulties, and how have you experienced this in your life?
